

## Calculating GPA for Selected Coursework

Follow these steps to calculate the grade point average you have earned for selected courses.

1. Select the courses you want to include in your calculation. Refer to the Huntington University catalog for information about coursework requirements for majors, minors, professional education or endorsements.
2. Convert the grades you will include in your calculation to their numerical values as listed below:

<b>A. = 4.00</b>	<b>A- = 3.67</b>		
<b>B+ = 3.33</b>	<b>B = 3.00</b>	<b>B- = 2.67</b>	
<b>C+ = 2.33</b>	<b>C = 2.00</b>	<b>C- = 1.67</b>	
<b>D+ = 1.33</b>	<b>D = 1.00</b>	<b>D- = 0.67</b>	<b>F = 0.00</b>

If you have repeated any of the courses that you are including in your calculations, count only the last grade you have received for a repeated course.

3. Multiply the numerical value of the grade you received for each course by the semester hour value of that course. This calculation will give you the honor points earned for each course you want to include in your gpa calculation.

*Example: If you received a grade of C+ for EN 151 Introduction to Literature (3 semester hours.), you should do the following calculation.*

$$C+ = 2.33$$

$$2.33 \times 3 \text{ semester hours.} = 6.99 \text{ honor points for this class}$$

*Your calculation shows that you earned 6.99 honor points for EN 151*

4. Calculate the honor points you have earned for each class and then add up the total honor points you have earned for all of the classes you want to include in your calculation.
5. Add up the total number of semester hours you have attempted in the coursework you are including. Remember to count hours for repeated coursework only once.
6. Divide the total honor points by the total semester hours. The answer is your grade point average for the courses you have selected.

*Example: The following example shows how to calculate the gpa for three English courses*

<b>Course</b>	<b>Sem Hours</b>	<b>Grade</b>	<b>Numerical Value</b>
EN 121 Academic Writ & Resrch	4.0	B-	B- = 2.67
EN 151 Introduction to Literature	3.0	C+	C+ = 2.33
EN 312 Communication Skills	2.0	B	B = 3.00

$$2.67 \times 4 \text{ hours} = 10.68 \text{ honor points}$$

$$2.33 \times 3 \text{ hours} = 6.99$$

$$3.00 \times 2 \text{ hours} = 6.00$$

-----

$$\text{Total honor points} = 23.67$$

$$\text{Total hours} = 9$$

$$23.67 / 9 = 2.63$$

*2.63 is the combined gpa for the three courses.*
