### MASTER OF ARTS IN PASTORAL LEADERSHIP ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

To be considered for admission to the Master of Arts in Ministry in Pastoral Leadership you must supply the following information. When this information is received, the Admissions Committee will review your application.

- ❑ A completed application form submitted electronically or mailed to following address:

- ❑ A non-refundable \$30.00 application fee that accompanies the application
- ❑ Submit a 2-3 page essay in response to each of the following:
  1. Describe your salvation experience and sense of calling to ministry
  2. Why are you pursuing a graduate degree in ministry?
  3. Describe your experience in ministry
- ❑ Official transcripts from highest degree conferring institution  
Undergraduate cumulative GPA of 3.0\* desired  
(degree in education not required for TESOL candidates)
- ❑ Recommendations (2)  
(from at least one pastor or spiritual leader)
- ❑ Prerequisites of 6 credit hours in Bible (Old and New Testament)  
and 3 credit hours in Theology)

Graduate credits earned at other regionally accredited institutions may be transferable to Huntington University's graduate programs. Only graduate courses with a grade of B- (2.67) or above are transferable. Generally such credits must be no older than 10 years and must represent courses that can reasonably substitute for courses in the Huntington University graduate program. Individual program directors determine the suitability of such courses for transfer credit and may deny transfer credit. Students will be asked to provide relevant materials for their transfer courses. Although credits may transfer, no transfer grades are recorded nor counted in the cumulative grade point average.

**Note:** The Admissions Committee may choose to waive some requirements for special circumstances.

Students may be accepted on a provisional basis until all prerequisites are completed. These requirements must be met within one year of beginning graduate coursework. Huntington University offers all necessary prerequisites for those accepted on a provisional basis.
